

## **CABLE BAY ADVENTURE PARK ACTIVITIES RISK DISCLOSURE:**

### **SKYWIRE**

One of the World's longest Flying Fox experiences - the one-of-a-kind ride is a shot of adrenaline mixed with an amazing scenic ride high above the forest canopy. Set 300 metres above the Base Cafe your trip starts with a 4km mini-bus journey up through the park to the launch platform of the Skywire. The ride takes up to 4 people at a time, seated side by side, strapped into individual racing car style seats with 5-point harnesses and can reach speeds of up to 100km/hr travelling both forward and backwards, with 800 metres of gravity assisted freewheeling in each direction. Universally appealing. NOTE: the Skywire is weather dependant and won't operate in high winds or rain.

**Min/max pax:** 1 – 4 in a single trip, can cater for up to 16 pax per hour + transfer time;

**Height restriction:** 1.2m

**Weight restriction:** None (passengers must be able to fit into the harnesses – 160kg+ catered for) - large groups will be split into pairs rather than fours – this may add to trip time.

**RISK DISCLOSURE:** The Skywire is not recommended for people with heart conditions, pregnant women, or medical conditions where a person may require immediate medical attention - please consult your doctor for advice if in doubt.

### **QUAD BIKE TOURS**

Combining excitement and adventure the quad bike tours are an unforgettable adventure where guests self-drive the quad bikes through native forest settings, around areas of the farm and up to the magnificent coastal views of the Cable Bay area.

Full instruction given and all drivers have a chance to hone their skills on the practise track prior to heading out on the tour.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Quad biking involves an inherent risk, and even following all safety precautions you could be injured or worse as a result of your or someone else's actions on the tour. Being a self-drive tour participants must accept they are in control of their own quad bike and their actions will directly impact on their own personal safety and potentially of those around them. Drivers must display a good level of competence prior to being allowed on the tour - anyone not meeting a minimum level will only be able to take the tour as a passenger if available. This is a scenic tour with low speeds. Any riders who are deemed to be putting themselves or others at unnecessary risk will be removed from the tour.

Self-drive trips are low speed scenic trips with lots of information and photo stops – average speed is less than 20kph
